

Entry to the venue:

All ticket holders have a specific Gate Entry. Please note the section on your ticket to find the closest gate of entry to your seat. This will ensure quick entry and help to avoid long lineups. Grandstand ticket holders in the 'West End' and/or 'East End' can enter through the West or East gates. All patrons with 'Field Seating' in Sections A, B, or C can enter through the Southeast gates. Patrons sitting in the 'South End' will enter through the South gates.



A thorough bag check will take place at entry gates, if you can, avoid bringing a bag with you, as this will help with a speedy entry.

Picking Up Your Tickets:

If you do not have your tickets yet, we encourage you to pick them up in advance of the show. This will help alleviate line ups at the box office will call entry points and make your concert going

experience more enjoyable. In advance, tickets can be picked up at the Brandt Centre Box Office. You will require your photo ID and the credit card used to buy the ticket.

There are two (2) Box Office locations at Mosaic Stadium located at the Southwest corner that will open at 11:00 am. In addition the Brandt Centre Box Office will be open from 10:00 am till 7:00 pm on August 14th, 2013.

Seating:

This is a Reserved Seat show. Everyone has an assigned seat. No general admission seating on the floor or in the stands. For safety reasons you will be required to stay in your seat during the show. Standing in the aisles will not be permitted.

Parking:

Parking at the Stadium is very limited. We encourage you to take the "Safe Ride to the Concert" City Transit service sponsored by SGI or car pool.

Parking at the Regina Sportplex and along North Railway is limited to pass holders only.

Handicap parking will be available on site.

Parking is available at Evraz Place via Lewvan Drive and Princess Street.

No Parking Tow Away Zone: (Signs will be installed prior to concert date)

- o 9th Avenue from Elphinstone Street to Albert Street
- o 10th Avenue from Elphinstone Street to Albert Street
- o Elphinstone Street from 9th Avenue to Saskatchewan Drive
- Dewdney Avenue from Garnet Street to Albert Street
- Albert Street from Dewdney Avenue to Saskatchewan Drive
- Retallack Street from 9th Avenue to 10th Avenue

Shuttle Services:

SGI is providing free shuttle service. Buses will be coming from malls around the city and will be parked in various locations for drop-off and pick-up. Pick-ups will begin at 5:30 p.m. and every 15 minutes until 7.45 p.m. .

Pick-up Locations:

- Normanview Landing by Robins Donuts
- Northgate Mall by Bank of Montreal
- Victoria Square Mall NE corner of the mall parking lot
- Southland Mall NE corner of the mall parking lot
- Walmart Rochdale Boulevard NE Corner of the mall parking lot

After the concert, the buses will be staged at:

- Normanview Landing south side of Dewdney Avenue between Robinson Street and Retallack Street
- Northgate Mall west side of Albert Street between Dewdney Avenue & 9th Avenue
- Victoria Square Mall west side of Albert Street between 9th Avenue & North Railway

- o Southland Mall south side of Dewdney Avenue between Rae Street & Robinson Street
- Walmart Rochdale Boulevard south side of Dewdney Avenue between Robinson Street and Garnet Street

Local Traffic:

Barricades will be set up in these areas and only cars with valid Taylor Field Area parking permits will be allowed to come through. Commissionaires will be monitoring the area. At 5 p.m. the following streets will be closed except to local traffic and emergency vehicles only:

- 9th Avenue from west of Elphinstone Street to east of Angus Street
- o Angus Street from Dewdney Avenue to 10th Avenue
- o Rae Street from Dewdney Avenue to 10th Avenue
- o Retallack Street from Dewdney Avenue to 10th Avenue
 - o (Note: Retallack Street from 9th Avenue to 10th Avenue will be closed all day)
- Robinson Street from Dewdney Avenue to 9th Avenue
- o Cameron Street from Dewdney Avenue to 9th Avenue
- o Garnet Street from Dewdney Avenue to 10th Avenue
- Athol Street from Dewdney Avenue to 10th Avenue
- Montague Street from Dewdney Avenue 10th Avenue
- o Elphinstone Street from Dewdney Avenue to North Railway Street

Gate Guidelines

The following items are **not** permitted on site: Animals – certified guide dogs only. No other animals are permitted | Illegal substances | Alcohol beverages | Outside food & beverages | Cans and bottles | Laser pens & pointers | Weapons of any kind | Fireworks, air horns, or whistles | Any object deemed to potentially pose a risk to our guests, staff, or artists (weapons, projectiles, spike collars and wrist bands, chains of long lengths, etc.) | Any flags or banners | Lawnchairs or Umbrellas | Bicycles, Skateboards, Rollerskates or Heely Shoes | Gang related colours or Paraphernalia | Audio/video recording devices & professional cameras (please see below for further clarity on the camera policy).

Special exceptions

Working animals will be allowed on site (i.e. guide dogs).

Designated seating areas for any patron requiring wheel chair or special seating consideration are paid tickets only through Ticketmaster.

Camera Policy

Guests may use personal cameras and cell phones to take photos within the venue; however, cameras with any size of detachable lenses will not be permitted on site. Video cameras or video

recording are not permitted at the show. To avoid distracting the artist and your fellow guests, please refrain from using flash at any point during the performance.

Food & Beverages

There will be a wide variety of food and beverage options on site. Purchases will be made at point of sale.

ATM

Most Concession and Beverage locations are Cash Only. For your convenience there will be many ATM machines located in the Stadium.

Taxi stands

Designated drop off and pick up locations are the Regina Sportplex (Fieldhouse) as well as Dewdney Ave at Angus Street.

Weather

As this is an outdoor venue – please be prepared for the weather. The show will happen – rain or shine! We suggest bringing a rain coat or poncho and layer up. We encourage you to leave the umbrella at home so everyone will be able to see the band without obstructions.
